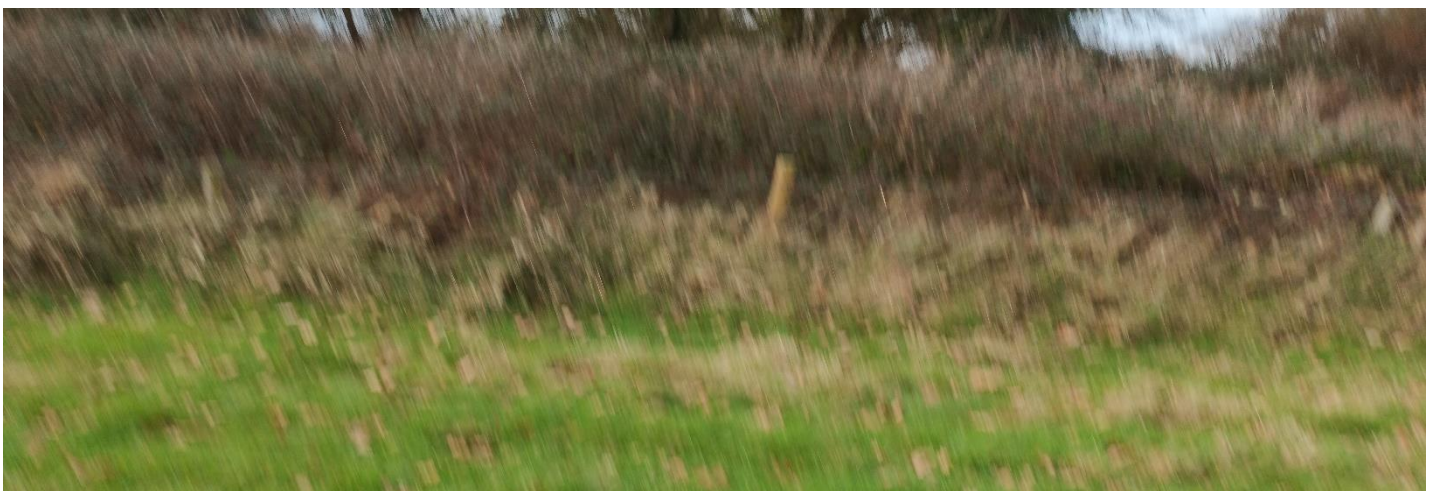

There will be another volunteer work party with members of the Manhood Wildlife and Heritage Group on Saturday 17th February from 10am to noon. It would be great if some of you could join us – with gloves, hedge trimmer, strimmer, rake or fork if you have them - please let me know so we know who to expect.

The aim is to clear the other half of the platform of bramble and lay some more weed control matting.

I am arranging a meeting with the local representative of the Church Commissioners, the owners of the land, and once we have their formal approval we will hire a contractor with a digger to help re-instate the platform.
